E.O. Nay Course #2 Clubhouse **USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY Local Rules** 1. No Play Zone – The flood control channel is deemed to be a no play zone, treated as a red penalty area. A ball must not be played and should not be retrieved from within the flood channel and relief must be taken from interference under PENALTY AREA options. 17.1b: All Bridges are in the no play zone. You must not play off the bridge. 2. Out of Bounds: Where fences have masonry or a concrete wall at their base, out of bounds is defined by the inside course-side edge of the wall, concrete and fence posts. The course-side edges of public roads are defined as out of bounds. A ball that crosses a road which is marked out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is out of bounds, even if it comes to rest on another part of the golf course. The paved cart path and its curbing behind the putting greens of Hole 18 is out of bounds. 3. All protective fences: Within the course that are not part of a boundary fence are deemed to be immovable obstructions. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1; however, there is no line of play relief. 4. **Penalty Areas:** All penalty areas are marked by red or yellow paint/stakes. If not marked or staked, the margin is defined by the course side of the rock wall behind Hole 12. On Hole 4 the concrete liner will define the margin of the lake, on Hole 3 and 4 by the channel liner. Relief under Rule 17.1b. 5. Ball on any decomposed granite roads or paths in the General Area: the player may take free relief under Rule 16.1. 6. **Drainage Area:** Hole 13 near the left side of the green. The player may take relief, no penalty. **Playing Guidelines:** Play "Ready Golf" at all times. Keep up with the group in front of you• Repair ball marks, replace **BROOKSIDE** divots and rake sand in bunkers • Carts must remain AT THE ROSE BOWL on path near all tees and greens. Please keep carts on path on all par 3's unless otherwise marked • You are responsible for any injury to people or damage to property caused by your actions, including errant golf shots. USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY Local Rules

- No Play Zone: The flood control channel is deemed to be a no play zone, treated as a red or yellow penalty area depending on how it is marked. A ball must not be played and should not be retrieved from within the flood channel. All bridges are in the no play zone. You must not play off the bridge. Relief must be taken under PENALTY AREA options.17.1b.
- 2. Out of Bounds: Where fences have masonry or a concrete wall at their base, out of bounds is defined by the inside course-side edge of the wall or concrete. The course-side edges of public roads are defined as out of bounds. A ball that crosses a road which is marked out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is out of bounds, even if it comes to rest on another part of the golf course. The driving range is deemed to be out of bounds. Its margins are defined by stakes and/or its fencing. The paved cart path and its curbing behind the putting greens of Holes 9 & 18 is out of bounds. The patio area behind #18 is "out of bounds".
- All protective fences: Within the course that are not part of a boundary fence are deemed to be immovable obstructions. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1; however, there is no line of play relief. 16.1.
- Penalty Areas: All penalty areas are marked by red or yellow paint/stakes. If not marked or staked the margin is defined by the water's edge. Relief under Rule 17.1b.
- Ball on any decomposed granite roads or paths in the General Area: the player may take free relief under Rule 16.1.

Playing Guidelines:

Play "Ready Golf" at all times. Keep up with the group in front of you • Repair ball marks, replace divots and rake sand in bunkers • Carts must remain on path near all tees and greens. Please keep carts on path on all par 3's unless otherwise marked • You are responsible for any injury to people or damage to property caused by your actions, including errant golf shots. General Information: Food and beverage may be ordered by calling (626) 577-4497• Only food and beverage purchased on premises are permitted • Restrooms are located on Holes 3, 11 and 15.
