

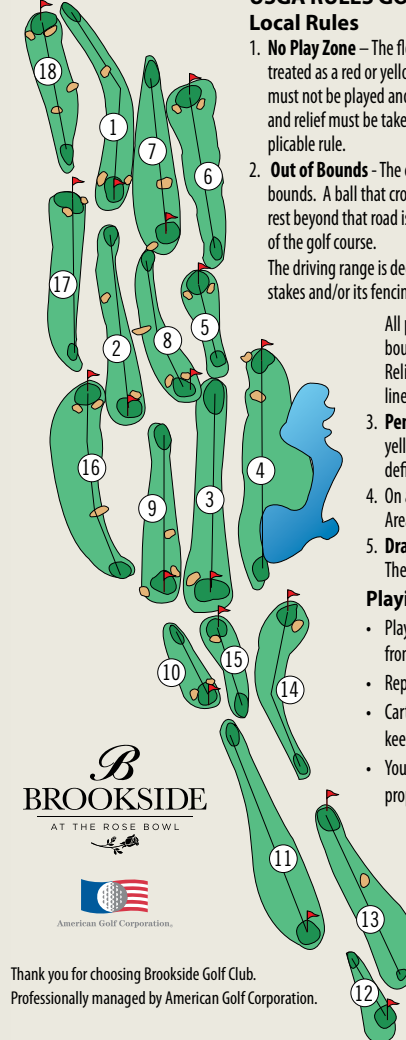

USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY

Local Rules

- No Play Zone** – The flood control channel is deemed to be a no play zone, treated as a red or yellow penalty area depending on how it is marked. A ball must not be played and should not be retrieved from within the flood channel and relief must be taken from interference by the no play zone under the applicable rule.
- Out of Bounds** - The course-side edges of public roads are defined as out of bounds. A ball that crosses a road which is marked out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is out of bounds, even if it comes to rest on another part of the golf course.
The driving range is deemed to be out of bounds. Its margins are defined by stakes and/or its fencing.

All protective fences within the course that are not part of a boundary fence are deemed to be immovable obstructions. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1; however, there is no line of play relief.

- Penalty Areas** - All penalty areas are marked by red or yellow paint/stakes. If not marked or staked the margin is defined by the water's edge
- On any decomposed granite (roads or paths) in the General Area the player may take free relief under rule 16.1.
- Drainage Area** - Hole #13 near the left side of the green. The player may take relief, no penalty.

Playing Guidelines

- Play "Ready Golf" at all times. Keep up with the group in front of you.
- Repair ball marks, replace divots and rake sand in bunkers.
- Carts must remain on path near all tees and greens. Please keep carts on path on all par 3's unless otherwise marked.
- You are responsible for any injury to people or damage to property caused by your actions, including errant golf shots.
